 LATE PICK-UP PROCEDURE: It is very important to pick up your child on time. Please check with the Site Coordinator at your child's school for the time you should pick your child up at the end of the day. You will be charged a late pick up fee of \$5.00 for the first 10 minutes after dismissal and \$1.00 for every minute thereafter. Children may not return to the recreation portion of the program until the late pick up fee is paid. If a child is not picked up on time, staff will call all contact numbers on the Emergency Contact List as provided by the parent. Calls will be made 5 minutes after dismissal, and again 10 minutes after dismissal, with final calls being made 20 minutes after dismissal. 25 minutes after dismissal, Stedman Elementary School will notify the police to pick up your child and take him or her to the nearest Denver District Police station. The police will be given the emergency contact information, and they will continue to try to reach someone to pick up the child. This may include, Denver Department of Human Services. Stedman Elementary will make every effort to contact someone at the emergency numbers you have provided. In the
